

## Parks and Recreation

## Welcome to South Portland Golf Course

The following rules & policies apply to this facility at ALL TIMES

- Hours of operation are sunrise to sunset daily unless otherwise posted
- Use of Alcohol, Drugs, or Tobacco is strictly prohibited in any parks & recreation facility
- Fires or fireworks, weapons, of any kind are prohibited without a permit
- Camping, illegal shelter, or overnight stays are prohibited without a permit
- Pets are not allowed on the Golf Course at any time
- Solicitation is prohibited without a permit at any park facility
- Motorized vehicles are restricted to public roadways and designated parking areas only
- Moving or misuse of structures or equipment without permission is prohibited
- · All persons shall use trash receptacles for the disposal of refuse. Littering is prohibited
- Household or commercial refuse in any park receptacle or on park property is prohibited
- Removal or destruction of plant materials or trees is prohibited
- All persons shall adhere to staff requests or posted warnings, policies, and directions
- All players must check in at the golf shop prior to their round and all play must begin on hole #1 unless authorized by the golf shop staff
- Club sharing and spectators are not allowed
- 4 players per group maximum without exception
- The golf shop attendant reserves the right to match up single players and twosomes into foursomes
- Shirts, with sleeves, must be worn and proper shoes are required at all times
- This is a NON-Metal spike facility
- The 3 R's Replace divots, Repair ball marks on greens, and Rake bunkers
- If Lightning is spotted in the area proceed immediately to the clubhouse
- Please stay off course when frost is present
- All golfers assume the risk of injury to themselves and any liability to other people or property for their actions. This includes stray golf balls that damage property outside of the golf course
