## Shawnee Peak Skiers and Riders Responsibility Code

- 1. Ski and ride under control and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid the other skiers or objects.
- 2. When skiing downhill or overtaking another skier, you must avoid the skier below you.
- 3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4. When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to others.
- 5. All skiers shall use devices to help prevent runaway skis or snowboards.
- 6. You shall keep off closed trails and posted areas and observe all posted signs.
- 7. If not familiar with use of lifts, ask attendant for instructions.

## In addition to the code please remember:

- Ski at a safe and reasonable rate of speed at all times, especially on crowded trails, on beginner trails, or in congested areas.
- Avoid skiing in packs.
- Always use appropriate language and behavior and always treat others with respect.
- · Always use safety bars when on lifts.
- Tickets, coupon, vouchers or passes are not transferable and may not be given or sold to others at any time.
