

Places to Ice Skate In Surrounding Towns:

Thompson's Point— Located at 10 Thompson's Pt. in Portland, is generally open from November-February (weather permitting). There is a fee of \$8.00 to use the rink and skate aids are available to rent for \$3.00. For information call (207) 222-3031 or visit their website at www.therinkatthompsonspoint.com.

Riverside Golf Course— Located at 1158 Riverside St. in Portland, has two skating ponds. The smaller of the two has lights for night time skating. They are open 24/7 and there are no fees associated with this location.



Scarborough Ice Rink— Located at 20 Municipal Dr., has an upper and lower rink. The upper rink is for hockey and the lower is for skating. There is no fee associated with this location. For information call (207) 883-7645.

Popular Trails to Snowshoe

Trails in South Portland:

Hinckley Park- A 40 acre park with 2 scenic ponds, that are viewable from the trails, that wrap around both ponds. It is about 3/4 of a mile to complete the main loop with smaller trails to extend your walk. Located off of Highland Ave. No day use fee.

Wainwright Farm Sports Complex- A 146 acre sports complex with groomed trails for snowshoeing. There is no fee for using this area and it is located at 125 Gary L. Maietta Way, South Portland.

Clark's Pond Trail- A 10 acre, 1.7 mile loop trail that starts in the Home Depot parking lot in South Portland. The loop goes through the woods and around the pond. You can either complete the loop by walking Westbrook St. back to Home Depot, or turn around and walk back through the woods. There is no fee for using the trail or parking lot.



Trails in Surrounding Area:

Fuller Farms Preserve- A 220 acre preserve located on Broadturn Road in Scarborough. There are 2.9 Miles of wooded and open field trails on the property with no fee to use parking lot or trails.

Smiling Hill Farm- Located in Westbrook on Rt. 22, there is a 500 acre, 15.5 mile groomed trail system that winds through open fields and wooded areas. There is a \$14.00 fee for adults and \$10.00 fee for ages 7-17. Children 6 and under are free.

Riverside Golf Course- Snowshoe on the 200 acre golf course with access 24 /7. There is no fee for using this area and the trails are groomed and marked. Off limit areas are roped off. Located at 1158 Riverside St. in Portland.

Pineland Farms- Located at 15 Farm View Dr. in New Gloucester. A total of 5,000 acres and almost 19 miles of groomed trails. The trails are open 8am-4pm daily and there is a day use fee of \$10.00 /person for full day or \$6.00/person for a half day (after 1pm).

Gilsland Farm Audubon Center- Located at 20 Gilsland Farm Rd. in Falmouth, has 65 acres and 2.5 miles of trails that walk by ponds, through meadows, an orchard, and salt marsh areas. They are open from dawn until dusk and there are no fees associated with this location.

Now That You Have Your Ice Skates, Where Can You Go?

In South Portland:

Mill Creek Park- A popular small pond located in South Portland. Open Dawn to 10pm (weather permitting). Lights at the pond are on from 4pm to 10pm. There is no fee for using this rink and there is available on street parking.



Wainwright Farm Sports Complex- Located in South Portland at 125 Gary L. Maietta Way. A rink is set up from November to March (weather permitting). There is plenty of parking and no fees associated with this location. Open 6am-9pm.
